HELPFUL HINTS FOR OUR YOUNGER DANCERS

Before Class:

Be prepared!

Please make sure your child has the correct dance shoes and clothing. You can find our requirements in our Dress Code section of this packet. We also offer suggestions on where to purchase required items.

Build excitement!

On your way to class, let your child know that they will have lots of fun and meet new friends! Remind them that you can watch them during class in the observation room(s).

Use the restroom

Make sure your child uses the restroom before class. If they need to go during class, the instructor or teaching assistant will let you know so that you can take your child to the bathroom if needed.

Get ready for class!

The timing of your arrival can affect how well your child will handle class. Try to arrive 10-15 minutes early so you and your child have plenty of time to use the restroom, change into dance clothing if needed, and make sure they have a filled water bottle.

During Class:

Allow the teachers to teach

Even if your child is having a hard time, please do not enter the studio. Your child will soon learn how to listen and work with their instructor. We know that this is a learning process for your child and that all children develop differently. If we do need you, we will bring your child out to you.

Relax and make friends!

Please take a chance to meet other parents! Take advantage of the time your child is in class and know that they are in good hands.

Don't worry if you can't see your child the entire time

Parents will be invited to come see what your child has been working on in class at certain points in the year, including at our in-house Winter Showcase (see further on in this packet for more information!)

After Class:

Remind your child that you are proud of them!

Even if your child had a hard time during class, remind them that they are doing a fantastic job and that they are still learning!

Please don't give up!

Tell them how excited you are to bring them back next week to make new friends and learn new things.





Why ballet?

Ballet comprises the "alphabet" of dance. In other words, we believe a **solid foundation** rooted in ballet will develop the **technique**, **skill** and **strength** required to excel in life and every other dance form.

What are my options for taking ballet at CAD?

We offer **two routes** for our ballet program, though both follow the esteemed Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet (<u>CPYB</u>) Training Syllabus. This graded syllabus (Ballet 1–4) sets your dancer on a trajectory to eventually pursue ballet and/or contemporary at a **pre-professional level.** For those looking to supplement their training while pursuing other genres, Ballet Fundamentals provides the ballet foundation necessary to do so.

Where do I go from there?

With a strong foundation in ballet, dancers develop into **capable**, **versatile** dancers with **refined technical skills**. In keeping a core proficiency in ballet, dancers can successfully explore other genres of dance such as **jazz**, **contemporary** and **acro arts**.

No matter your age or ability, however dance fits into your life, Class Act Dance is the place to start!

- Shoes not required



Mini Stars

- Pink skirted leotard, pink convertible tights
- Pink ballet shoes. black tap shoes



Steps & Styles

- Black leotard, pink convertible tights
- Socks for ballet, tan jazz shoes, black tap shoes



Ballet (Pre-Ballet Level 4)

- Girls: Black leotard, pink convertible tights, pink ballet shoes
- Boys: Plain white t-shirt, black ballet pants or leggings, black ballet shoes



Intro to Jazz

- Black leotard, pink convertible tights, shorts over if desired
- · Tan jazz shoes



Jazz (Levels 1-4)

- Black leotard or tight tank top/tee shirt (no crop tops, please), leggings or jazz (yoga) pants
- Tan jazz shoes



Acro + Contemporary

- Tight, athletic clothing
- Shoes- pink ballet shoes for Intro level, cotton dance socks for Levels 3+


